OPENING

SOUND: Narrator’s Microphone, DJ standby

MASTER OF CEREMONIES: Good Evening Ladies and Gentlemen. Welcome to the Krewe of Antheia inaugural ball. Tonight, we will celebrate “Let’s Geaux Girls”. My name is Trey Brownfield, and I will be your Master of Ceremonies this evening.

CAPTAIN BLOWS WHISTLE

LIGHTS: STAGE

MASTER OF CEREMONIES: Ladies and gentlemen – please rise and remain standing for the National Anthem.

LIGHTS: STAGE

SOUND: NONE

MASTER OF CEREMONIES: Please be seated.

The Goddess Antheia was the goddess of vegetation, gardens, blossoms and was especially worshipped in the spring and near lowlands and marshlands. Her name is derived from the Ancient Greek word that means flower or blossom. She was also the Goddess of human love. Her symbols are gold colored items like honey and myrrh.

SOUND LET'S GO GIRLS!

BALL CAPTAIN AND CO-CAPTAIN ENTER THROUGH CENTER AISLE, PROMENADE ENDING AT RIGHT OF STAGE.

FLOAT LIEUTENANTS LINE UP AT BACK OF ROOM. AS NAME IS CALLED, ENTER THROUGH THE MAIN AISLE, WAVE AND PROMENADE. UPON APPROACHING THE STAGE, LIEUTENANTS WILL SPLIT, LINING UP TO LEFT AND RIGHT SIDES OF DANCE FLOOR, ALTERNATING FIRST GOES LEFT, NEXT GOES RIGHT AND SO ON.
